ABSTRACT

The new issue of ‘Andalucía en la Historia’, magazine edited by the Centro de Estudios Andaluces Foundation, brings together a gallery of moderate andalusian politicians and intellectuals who supported a parliamentary monarchy model, similar to the political system of France or England between 1820-1823. This important period in Spanish history, known as “Trienio Liberal” or “Trienio Constitucional,” was a short but intensive time of political changes in a Europe mostly dominated by absolutism.
